Students must meet this criterion in order to be eligible to walk the stage in June.

We have a lot of fun and engaging events taking place at our school this month, so we hope that you will take a moment to find time to get involved. From parent engagement opportunities to student events, there are many ways for you to get involved at Morrill this month. We hope you have a great start to the year and we look forward to seeing you around campus!
