

6th Grade Orientation (WEB Day)

The Where Everybody Belongs (WEB) program at Morrill is hosting a hybrid 6th grade orientation this year. On August 12th, starting at 8:30am, the 6th grade students will have the opportunity to log into a Zoom meeting to meet their WEB Leader, classmates, and learn about the school. Students will receive an email from their WEB Leader with the link to the Zoom meeting. Please have your student check their school email daily starting August 6th to ensure they do not miss any information. At 11:00am, parents may drop their student off in the BYC parking lot, where 6th grade students will meet their WEB Leader and Advisory classmates in person. Students will have an opportunity to play games with their WEB team, take a tour of the school, and receive their schedule for the year. Parents should plan to pick up their student at 12:30pm, at which time parents can go into campus and turn in the ABC forms and any documents that need to be submitted before students start school.

Bully-Free Zone

It is our goal to support all of our students in maintaining a safe and productive learning environment that is free of verbal, physcial, emotional, and cyber bullying. While cyber bullying has become a serious issue nationwide, Morrill Middle School has several measures in place to support our students in experiencing a bully-free school environment.

One support we have in place is our anonymous reporting system. Morrill has implemented the TipNow system, which allows our students, parents, and teachers to submit anonymous "tips" to the school administration notifying them of any bullying or unsafe behavior that is taking place on or around the campus. We encourage all of our students to save the TipNow number in their phone, and use it as needed to assist in managing the safety of our campus.

<u>Attendance</u>

Morrill Middle School starts every day at 8:00am. It is imperative that your student(s) arrive to school on time each day. We encourage your student to arrive on campus around 7:45am so they have an opportunity to socialize with their friends and make it to class in a timely manner. When your student arrives on time, they are more likely to be prepared for the day and are more likely to become successful students. There is a direct correlation between students who arrive to school on time and students who are academically and socially successful in school. Please make an effort to have your student arrive before the first bell rings so that they are able to receive all necessary information they need in their Advisory class each morning.

If your student is not feeling well and needs to miss a day of school, please take the time to call our front office to inform us of the absence. When students have excess unexcused absences, it requires the school to report those absences to the State and could lead to legal consequences. Making your students' attendance a priority will go a long way in supporting their overall achievement in school.



- Regular attendance is required to stay enrolled. Consistent absences will result in removal from program and space will be offered to the next student on the waiting list


REGISTRATION
